

Primary Fundraising Includes Hospital & Paper Crusade

Hospital fundraising; Annual drive directly supports our hospitals operations (takes place September through December)

Paper Crusade fundraising; annual event that directly supports our annual newspaper crusade operations, the El Hasa Shrine and associated Clubs & Units (takes place September through December 1)



Fundraising Charitable & Fraternal

Charitable <u>fundraising</u>: supports our hospitals and Children's Healthcare Systems
