# Why Relocate Hospital

- ▶ Changing healthcare trends and improved technology
- ▶ Better safety standards for children = fewer burns
- ▶ Children have better outcomes when they can be at home; increased focus on outpatient care
- ▶ Right-size the hospital – 7 inpatient beds, not 30

- ▶ Opportunity to collaborate on complex medical conditions, providing new care services for children

- ▶ Maintain burn center presence in Midwest/Mid-Atlantic/Southeast

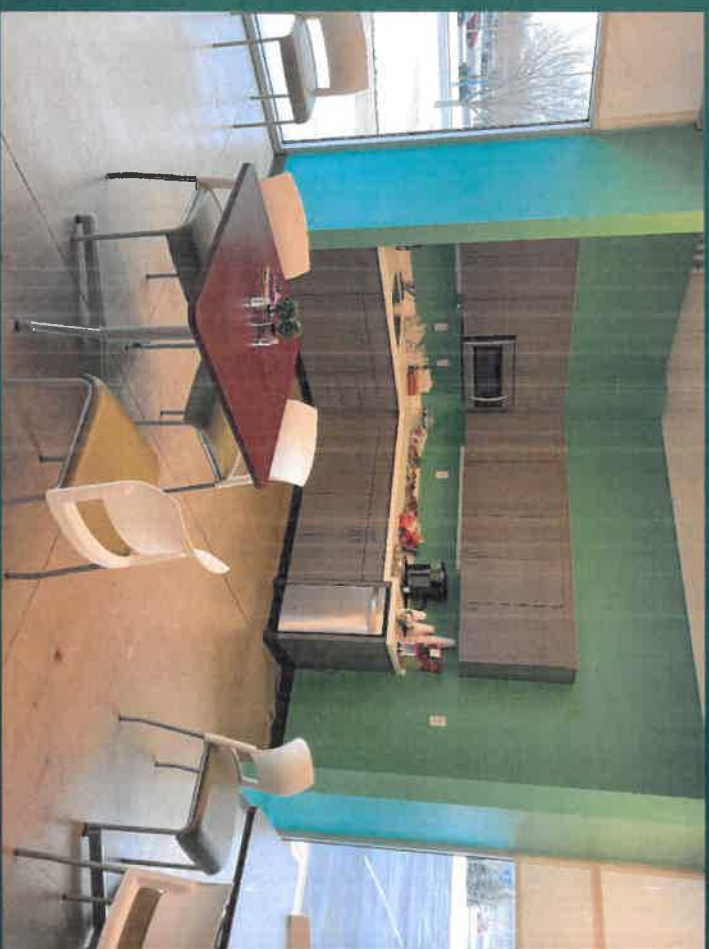
