Stated Meeting and Election of 2025 Officers

Notice is hereby given that a stated meeting of El Hasa Temple will be held at the El Hasa Center on Monday, December 02, 2024 at 7:30 p.m. at which time the Elective Officers and Representatives to the Imperial Council shall be elected and all Temple business as may regularly come before this meeting.

Your attention is called to Section 325.11 of the Imperial Council By-Laws, Section 325.11 Election Regulations:

- (a) Electioneering. A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices by a unit, club, Noble or groups of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- (b) Expenditures Prohibited. The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- (c) Violation. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers' void and order a new election.
- (d) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.

MESSAGE FROM THE RECORDER

Dear Shrine Mason:

Greetings to each of you with my fraternal, best wishes for the good our Masonic fraternity and El Hasa Shrine!

There have been questions raised about the increase of \$50.00 with your yearly dues of \$145.00 with El Hasa Shriners. I wanted to explain how it was enacted. A motion was proposed by several Nobles for an increase of \$50.00 in yearly dues. The membership was notified in advance, and it was laid over until the March 2023 stated meeting of the proposed increase. A vote was taken and passed that there would be an increase of dues. Several steps in reviewing the process were taken by Shriners International with the Jurisprudence and Laws Committee to see everything was in order with the dues increase to run its course for it to be effective at the start of the Shrine year 2025.

Please see the reasons for a proposed increase in your yearly dues for 2025. They are due to the budget in running temple operations, the economy with the cost of living, the decline in temple membership, the non-payment of dues by members, deaths of our active membership, and to day-to-day expenses that we encounter with El Hasa Shriners. This can be contributed to multiple factors of having an increase proposed and implemented for the future of El Hasa.

El Hasa Shrine has been noted as being an active and vibrant membership that are sensitive to the needs of the shrine member. We need your active participation and involvement for the success of our El Hasa Shrine fraternity. You play an important and integral role in the success of our Shrine of El Hasa, our international fraternity, and our philanthropy with Shriners Hospitals for Children.


