Addison's Story

Addison Christian is a very active 15-year-old. She is a multiple sport athlete. She plays Varsity Softball, Basketball, Volleyball, cross country, Dance team and competitive tumbling. Which in tumbling she is a state champion and top 5 national winner She also is on two travel softball team with a batting average of .540 last year and 50 stolen bases. We never thought she would scoliosis with a degree of 12. When she hit puberty, her degree went to 36 and was referred to Cincinnati Children's when our insurance would not cover the treatment they refereed us to Shriners which was a God sent. First, I had no idea that they would help children with insurance. From our very first appointment at 12 to now at 15 they have been nothing but good to us. Addison had to wear a brace for two years to try and slow the progress down. The great thing about Shriners is everything in one place. If her prosthetic needed adjustment, we done that there that day, when she needed physical therapy again it was there and finally if she needed a lung test because her curved was affect her lungs it was done there all the same day. She has a whole team of health care workers at her fingertips and not to mention she would get a present every time she went. Addison has three curves and makes her spine a S-shape which is the most danger form because it rotates and twists the spines

bones different ways as it bends sideways causing lung and heart problems. She has a left upper thoracic 33-degree curve at T1-T5, right upper thoracic 62-degree T5-L1 and left thoracolumbar 27-degree L1-L5. The scoliosis has also made the right-side rib cage higher, right hip higher and right shoulder dyskinesia. Addison plans on having spinal fusion with two rods, screws and hooks with Dr. Talwalker on March 26. Through this journey we are so grateful for Shriners. Dr.

Talwaker and her team of health care workers. When we have questions, pain or new problems they have worked us in the same day no questions or problem was to little. Dr. Talwalker goal was to keep her in sports and he has achieved that for her and now his new goal is to get her back on the basketball court for the 2025 season. Our family appreciates everything the Shriners have done for Addy, and we are grateful for the care she has received. Actually, Addy will have to do a senior project which she attends to raise money to give back to Shriners.




